TORONTO (April 1, 2015) – After six seasons of highs and lows, Jackie Peyton (Edie Falco) is battered and broken, but betting on a bright future. The Movie Network scrubs up one last time for the seventh and final season of the Emmy-winning dark comedy from SHOWTIME, [NURSE JACKIE](#).
